## **Concorso d'Eleganza Villa d'Este 2016: Jury confers awards on the first winners.**

**Awards for the best preserved pre-war and post-war automobiles in the contest, the best iconic vehicle, the most elegant vehicle of the marque Rolls-Royce, the best interior design, the most spectacular exterior, the most sensitive restoration and the car driven from farthest away +++ The world's most exclusive beauty contest for historic automobiles and motorcycles comes to an end on Sunday with the award of the class winners and the conferment of the Trofeo BMW Group for the Best of Show.**

**Munich/Cernobbio.** At the Concorso d'Eleganza Villa d'Este 2016, the specialist Jury composed of international experts declared the first winners on Saturday.
